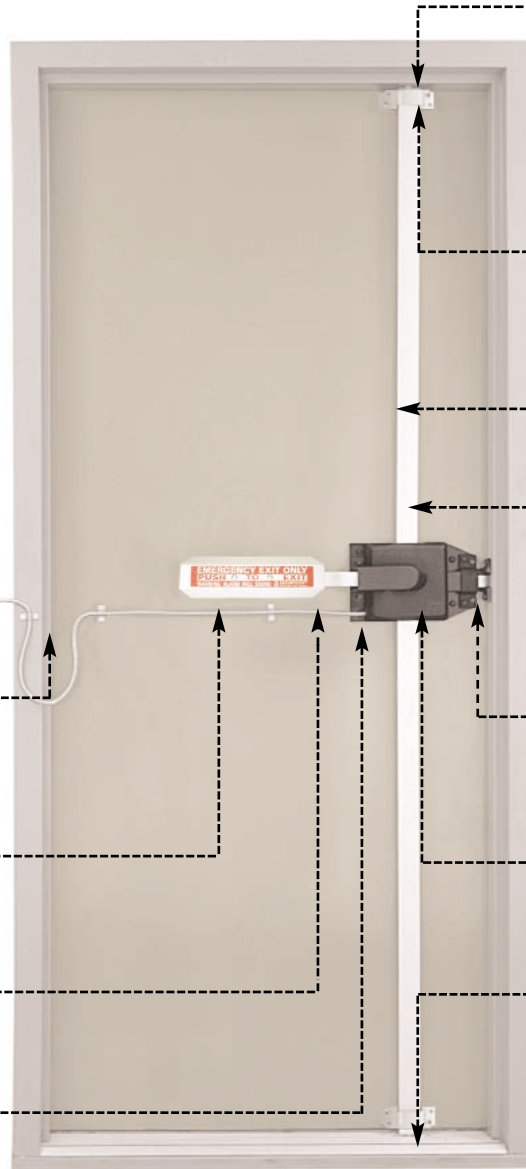

Alarm Signal Switch Initiated By Paddle Movement
